REQUIREMENTS FOR 2017 RENEWAL

Current COA/CTPs will be valid until you complete the APRN license renewal process or until December 31, 2017.

***ADVANCED PHARMACOLOGY**

- Must complete a 45-hour course of study in Advanced Pharmacology from a Board of Nursing-approved program within the last 5 years.
 - A minimum of 36 hours must be from a single provider.
- The education must include: fiscal/ethical implications of prescribing, “state and federal” laws applicable to prescribing, instruction specific to Schedule II which includes pain management therapies, fiscal/ethical implications for Schedule II, “state and federal” laws about Schedule II, prevention of abuse, and diversion of Schedule II.

CE REQUIREMENTS FOR 2017 RENEWAL (does not apply to new graduates)

- All APRNs will need to renew their RN license and apply for the APRN license in 2017.
- The current CE requirements have not changed for the 2017 renewal period.
- The CE requirements under HB 216 will need to be met before you renew your RN and APRN licenses in 2019.
