APRN Licensure Implementation Plan

Renewal for 2017

- Renewal Deadlines:
 - For RNs – October 31, 2017
 - For APRNs – December 31, 2017 (CNSs, CNMs, CNPs, and CRNAs)

- CRNAs
 - At the start of renewal on July 1, 2017, CRNAs may renew and will become licensed. Because they never have had CTPs to prescribe, there are no issues regarding prescribing. Deadline to renew is December 31, 2017.

- CNSs, CNMs, CNPs with:
 - CTP or CTP-E: They renew by December 31, 2017 and once renewed, they become licensed.

 - No CTP or CTP-E
 - Have completed the 45-hours of advanced pharmacology within the last five years
 - Attest on the application they have completed it and upload the documents
 - Do **not** have the 45-hours of advanced pharmacology within the last five years
 - Cannot continue renewal process until they complete the 45-hours and upload the documents. They have until December 31, 2017.

New COAs and CTPs for Graduates of Ohio Programs on or after April 4, 2017

- The Board plans *not* to issue COAs, CTP/CTP-Es after the effective date.
 - CRNAs – begin licensing upon the effective date of the bill

 - CTPs/CTP-Es – Discontinue issuing upon the effective date of the bill

 - CNSs, CNPs, CNMs
 - On or after the effective date of the bill, the Board will **license** new graduates of Ohio programs, because they will have the 45-hours within 5 years as part of their graduate program. The Board will issue the license if the application submission is within a five-year period from graduation.

Inactive or Lapsed COAs or CTPs on or after April 4, 2017 must apply for Reactivation or Reinstatement

- CRNAs: Reactivate or reinstate as currently do, but they become licensed
- CNSs, CNPs, CNMs with inactive or lapsed CTP or CTP-E
 - Reactivate or reinstate to become licensed. Because they previously held a CTP or CTP-E, they are eligible for licensure
- CNSs, CNPs, CNMs and never had a CTP
 - They must attest that they completed the 45-hour advanced pharmacy requirement within the past 5 years and upload the documents in order to reactivate or reinstate

Reciprocity (Endorsements) on or after April 4, 2017

- All applicants must attest to completing a graduate nursing degree program that included 45-hours of advanced pharmacy with the content specified in Section 4723.482, ORC, in past 5 years, and upload the documents.
